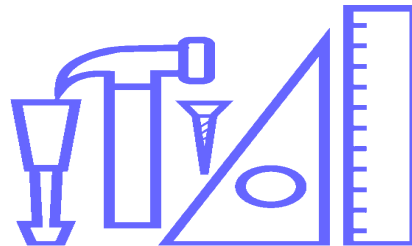

AN EXCITING SERVICE OPPORTUNITY

There exists in the United States a need for volunteers to respond to the many building needs of churches.

With high cost of construction facing each church, volunteers play a significant role in reducing costs. In fact, many churches would not exist today without volunteer help.

BUILDERS FOR CHRIST (BFC) was organized to involve individuals and/or families in missions. BFC has been designed as another opportunity for the building needs in the United States. BFC was not created to replace other building teams, such as, Mission Service Corp., Christian Service groups, etc., but to supplement them and to provide opportunities for churches to serve.

BFC assists churches and missions build new or additional buildings.

BFC will enlist a superintendent (who will be the key person) and a volunteer team. Their job will be to put the building under roof in six days, as well as erect the inside partitions, baptistery, and platform. The church may enlist outside help to work with the BFC.

BFC will assist the church in selecting electricians, plumbers, carpenters, painters, etc., as needed.

Several months prior to the work week, a representative from the BFC will contact the church to provide guidance in planning the building and preparing for construction.

Each Church is required to complete an application which describes its responsibilities. Major items include: obtaining a date for construction and adhering to that date, preparing the foundation, providing BFC worker's room and board during their stay, providing church family to be on site to work with volunteers.

BFC also assists churches by enlisting help from other states.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Volunteers are needed in the following areas:

- ✦ Bricklaying
- ✦ Plastering
- ✦ Plumbing
- ✦ Electrical
- ✦ Air Conditioning
- ✦ Carpentry
- ✦ Painting
- ✦ Building Superintendent
- ✦ Any other specialized skills
- ✦ Individual with desire for mission work
